Forms of Clemency

"EXTRA-JUDICIAL" POWER

LAST DITCH EFFORT TO SECURE RELIEF FROM SENTENCE OR CONVICTION:


Pardon: "undoes" the conviction and its consequences

Commutation: converts a sentence to a lesser sentence

Reprieve: offers temporary relief from the imposition of sentence

"This is indeed **one of** the great advantages of monarchy in **general**,...that there is a magistrate, who has it in his power to extend mercy, wherever he thinks it is deserved: holding a **court of** equity in his own **breast**, to soften the rigour of the general law, in such criminal cases as merit an exemption from punishment."



Monarchical Underpinnings of the "Mercy Function"

"Humanity and good policy conspire to dictate, that the **benign** prerogative of pardoning should be as little as possible **fettered** or embarrassed. The criminal code of every country partakes so much of necessary severity, that without an easy access to exceptions in favor of unfortunate guilt, justice would wear a countenance too sanguinary and cruel."

The Founders' Belief in the "Benign Prerogative of Pardoning"

"Until I can be sure that everyone sentenced to death in Illinois is truly guilty, until I can be sure with moral certainty that **no** innocent man or woman is facing lethal injection, no one will meet that fate. We must ensure the public safety of our citizens but, in doing so, we must ensure that the ends of justice are served."
